Here are some facts from Porci's Ocean Patrol episode 1. Can you find the underlined words in the wordsearch?

- The Great Southern Reef is home to the Leafy Sea Dragon.
- Lots of common bathroom products contain microbeads, which end up in our ocean and can be mistaken for food by our sea life.
- Leafy Sea Dragons' favourite food is a small crustacean called a Mysid. They eat these by slurping through their pipe-like snout.
- The male Leafy Sea Dragon holds the bright pink eggs on the sticky underside of his tail. This is called a brood patch.
- In Kurna language, the word for head is mukarda.
