- The Great Southern Reef is home to the Leafy Sea Dragon.
- Lots of common bathroom products contain microbeads, which end up in our <u>ocean</u> and can be mistaken for <u>food</u> by our <u>sea</u> life.
- Leafy Sea Dragons' favourite food is a small crustacean called a <u>Mysid</u>.
