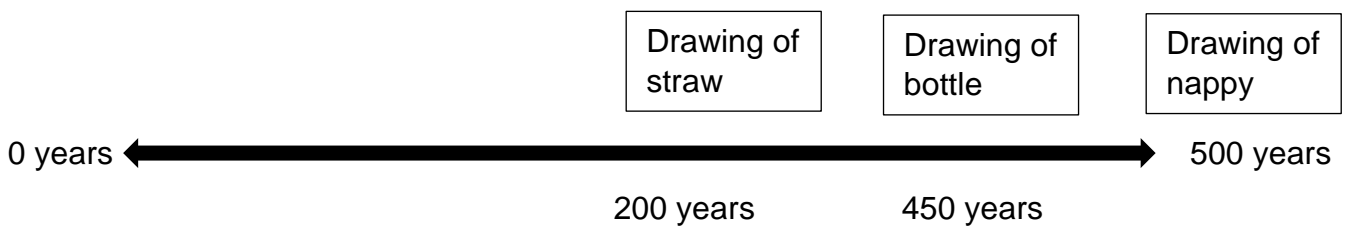
2. Why are tiny plastics harmful to all types of wildlife?
