- A **reef** can be made up of rocks or stony corals depending on where they are growing.
- In the Great Southern Reef, the cooler temperate waters are favoured by **seaweed** covered rocks.
- A reef can either be **naturally** made by rocks or corals or artificially made by humans with old items such as tyres or sunken ships.
- **Zooplankton** are small creatures such as mysids, **copepods** or even the larvae of larger animals.
- Zooplankton eat a plant-like **algae** called Phytoplankton who float around our oceans and use sunlight to get their energy.
- The traditional Kaurua name for a boomerang is a **wadna**.
- There are many different types of boomerangs which are all used for different reasons such as **hunting**, for protection, and to create **music**.
