- Aboriginal people have a rich tradition of dancing, they have dances for celebrations, storytelling, and ceremonies.
- Dancers paint themselves with beautiful designs and move to the rhythm of the didgeridoo and clapsticks.
- Saltwater will freeze at minus 2 degrees Celsius whereas freshwater will freeze at 0 degrees Celsius.
- Antarctica's icy cold waters contain lots of nutrients, so they are important for phytoplankton blooms and krill.
- In the Adelaide Dolphin Sanctuary, there are about 30 bottlenose dolphins.
- Dolphins have excellent vision both above and below the water.
