- Aboriginal people have a rich tradition of <u>dancing</u>, they have dances for <u>celebrations</u>, storytelling, and ceremonies.
- Dancers <u>paint</u> themselves with beautiful designs and move to the rhythm of the didgeridoo and <u>clapsticks</u>.
