- Aboriginal people have a rich tradition of <u>dancing</u>, they have dances for <u>celebrations</u>, storytelling, and ceremonies.
- Dancers' <u>paint</u> themselves with beautiful designs and move to the rhythm of the didgeridoo and **clapsticks**.
- Saltwater will <u>freeze</u> at minus 2 degrees Celsius whereas freshwater will freeze at 0 degrees Celsius.
- Antarctica's icy cold waters contain lots of **nutrients**, which is important for phytoplankton blooms and krill for whales to eat.
